Dear Friends,

The vision of the Springfield Foundation is to improve the quality of life in our area for now and for generations to come. We carry out our vision by partnering with donors, other funders and local nonprofits. This 2015 annual report highlights several partnerships we were involved in during the year. At the end of 2015, the Foundation held 356 endowment funds. Included in those are endowments with 56 local nonprofits.

Partnering with our community is important to the Springfield Foundation, and our PIP (Partners in Philanthropy) drive is just one example of our strong and growing partnerships. Our PIP drive was created in 1995 as a way to invite the entire community to assist in partnering with the Foundation to help make our community a better place to live. Over the years there has been more than \$640,000 contributed through the drive. These dollars are important for the operation of the Foundation. We are celebrating the 20th year of the drive and are thankful to everyone who has contributed.

The Springfield Foundation created 38 new endowment funds with assets of \$6.6 million in 2015. Total assets were at \$70 million at the end of 2015. In the distribution area, we distributed more than \$6.9 million in grants and scholarships. 2015 was another busy and successful year at the Springfield Foundation. Thank you for choosing the Springfield Foundation to be your community partner.

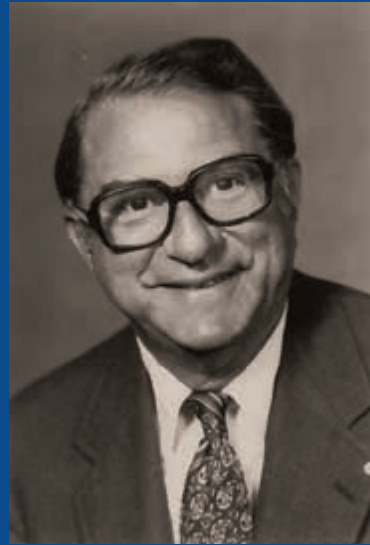

Scholarship Endowment Partnership

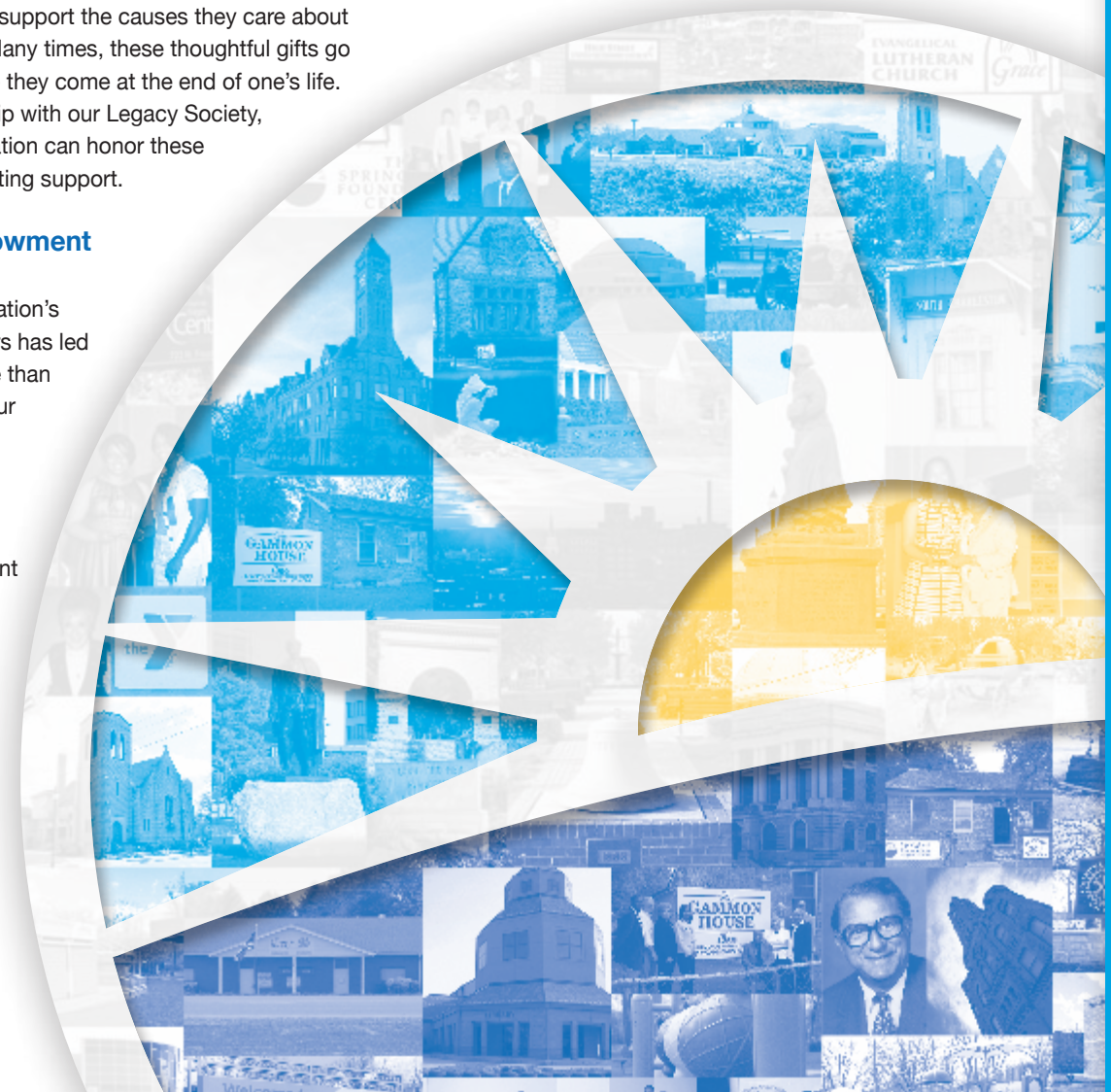

New Endowment Funds

Celebrating *our* Passions *for our* Community



In 2015, the following donors partnered with the Springfield Foundation to create permanent endowment funds. These new funds will have an impact forever and each builds upon our shared lives and passions.

The Champaign Residential Services Inc., Endowment Fund

was established to provide current income and long-term protection for the operations of Champaign Residential Services Inc.

Edwards Family Scholarship Fund

was originally established as a Horizon Fund. The Fund endowed into a scholarship fund on September 15, 2015. The scholarship is awarded to graduates of a Clark County High School attending Cedarville University.

Frank Giampetro Scholarship Fund

was established by Michael and Jenny Lambert in honor of Frank Giampetro, for his tireless efforts at Greenon High School supporting the Band and Music Department. The scholarship assists Greenon High School graduating seniors in Band to further their studies at an accredited two- or four-year college or university.



Jane P. B. Hollenbeck Ridgewood School Capital Endowment Fund

was established by The Jane P. B. Hollenebeck Trust to benefit Ridgewood School for its remodeling and expansion.

Jane P. B. Hollenbeck Ridgewood School Endowment Fund

was established by The Jane. P. B. Hollenbeck Trust for the remodeling and expansion of Ridgewood School.

L. Edwin and Mary C. Hoppes Memorial Family Fund is a Family Donor Advised fund established for the children of Edwin and Mary C. Hoppes.

Hoppes International Study Scholarship Fund was established by Rick and Nina Hoppes to help Kenton Ridge High School students and graduating seniors meet the participation costs of an international study program.

Highlands United Church of Christ Endowment Fund was established for the unrestricted support of the charitable or educational purposes of Highlands United Church of Christ and its affiliated agencies.

Richard E. Kramer Scholarship Fund was established as a horizon fund by Sondra Kramer and her daughters in memory of Richard Kramer, a longtime community supporter with an appreciation of the importance of the pursuit of education. It became fully endowed in March 2015. The scholarship assists Clark County graduates to further their studies at any two- or four-year accredited college or university.

Barbara F. Matthies Scholarship Fund was established by Barbara F. Matthies, a graduate of Springfield High School, who was a university professor for 30 years. The scholarship assists graduates of a public high school in Clark County, Ohio who are currently enrolled in a Bachelor's degree program at an accredited four-year institution of higher learning in Ohio. Preference is given to applicants who major in Liberal Arts or Education.

Daniel P. and Judith S. McGregor Family Advised Fund was established to support organizations in the areas of Arts and Culture, Human Services, Civic Affairs, Education, and Health, which provide services in Clark County.

John Minchin UAW Scholarship Fund was established to assist students whose parents or grandparents are an active, retired or deceased member of the U.A.W. Local 402 or the surviving spouse of the member, to further their studies at an accredited two- or four-year college or university, including trade and technical schools.



South Charleston Community Club Scholarship Fund was established for Southeastern High School graduating seniors who are enrolled in a two- or four-year college or university, including trade and technical schools.

Springforward Fiscal Sponsorship Fund was established for the revitalization and renovation of downtown Springfield.

Shanley Foundation Endowment Fund was established to provide support to several charities serving Clark County.

Springfield City School District Auditorium Endowment Fund was established for the support, maintenance, and operating expenses of an auditorium for the Springfield City School District.

SHS Scholarships Program Fund was established in 2008 by alumni of the Springfield High School community, led by 1957 graduate Dr. Jack Hutslar. The permanent endowment was created at the Springfield Foundation in 2015.

The scholarship assists Springfield High School graduates who demonstrate outstanding service, academic achievement and financial need to further their studies at an accredited two- or four-year college or university.

Robert D. Jackson United Way Endowment Fund was established to provide current income and long-term protection for the operations of United Way of Clark, Champaign and Madison Counties.

Urbana University Fund was established to provide current income and long-term protection for the operations of Urbana University.

United Rehabilitation Services of Springfield Endowment Fund was established to provide current income and long-term protection for the operations of United Rehabilitation Services of Springfield.



Veterans Park Endowment Fund was established to provide current income and long-term protection for the operations of Veterans Park.

Springfield Family YMCA Fund was established to provide current income and long-term protection for the operations of Springfield Family YMCA.

Yellow Springs Senior Center Endowment Fund is an Agency Endowment fund established for the unrestricted use of the Yellow Springs Senior Center.

Celebrate and Remember Me...

Through One Grant and One Scholarship At A Time



Each year we *Celebrate our Life, Passion and Community* by providing grants to meet local needs in a broad range of areas including: Arts and Culture, Civic Affairs, Conservation-Environment-Animal Welfare, Education, Health, and Human Services.

In 2015 more than \$7,400,000 in grants and scholarships were awarded. Discretionary grants including out-of-cycle and executive director grants totaled \$486,756. Scholarship awards from all funds totaled \$488,444 and included 315 new and renewal awards. These grants and scholarships are awarded in the following ways:

Discretionary Grants are supported by the Foundation's unrestricted and field of interest funds. These general community grants are awarded annually to local 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations located in, or providing direct support to, Clark County through a competitive application process. The grant application, guidelines, and due dates are available on our website springfieldfoundation.org. Grants are awarded in December of each year.



Clark County Leadership Academy

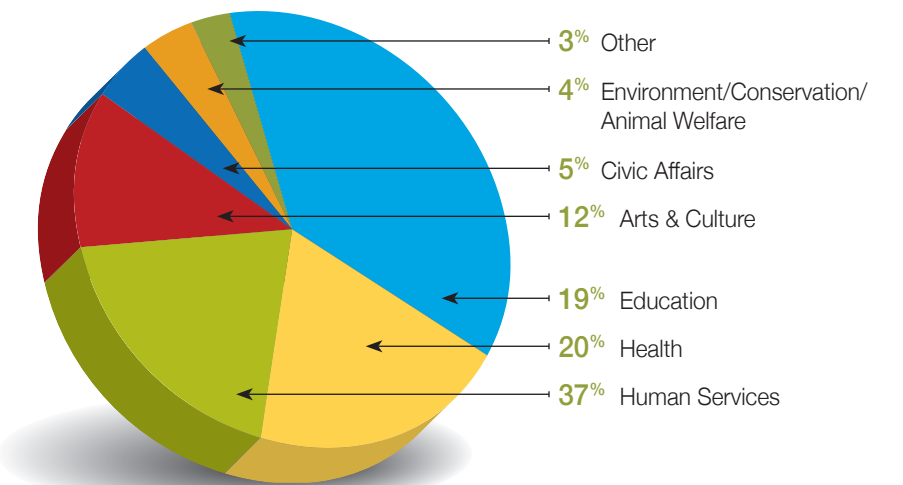
Designated Grants ensure long-term annual support to nonprofit organizations. These grants come from funds established by donors to support one or more organizations. No application is required and grants are usually made in December of each year.

Donor Advised Grants are made at the recommendation of donors who have established permanent donor advised funds or Charitable Checking funds through the Foundation. Following guidelines established by our Board of Trustees, donors may suggest grants to 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations both locally and throughout the United States. No application is required and grants may be made by donors throughout the year.

Scholarship Awards come from scholarship funds established by donors to help area students afford a college education. Scholarships may be created with specific selection criteria or with general requirements. Most scholarships are need-based. *A Guide to Scholarship Funds and Requirements*, along with application materials, are available on our website springfieldfoundation.org in late November and awards are made in May.

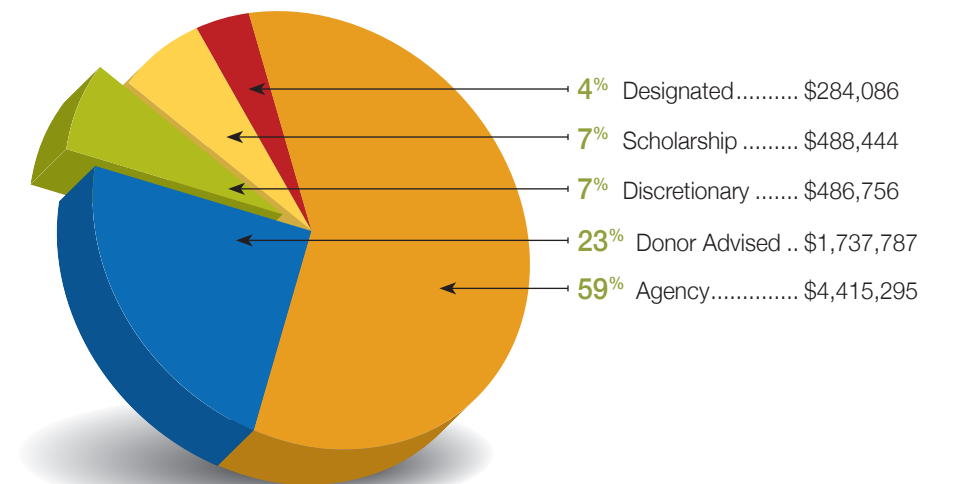

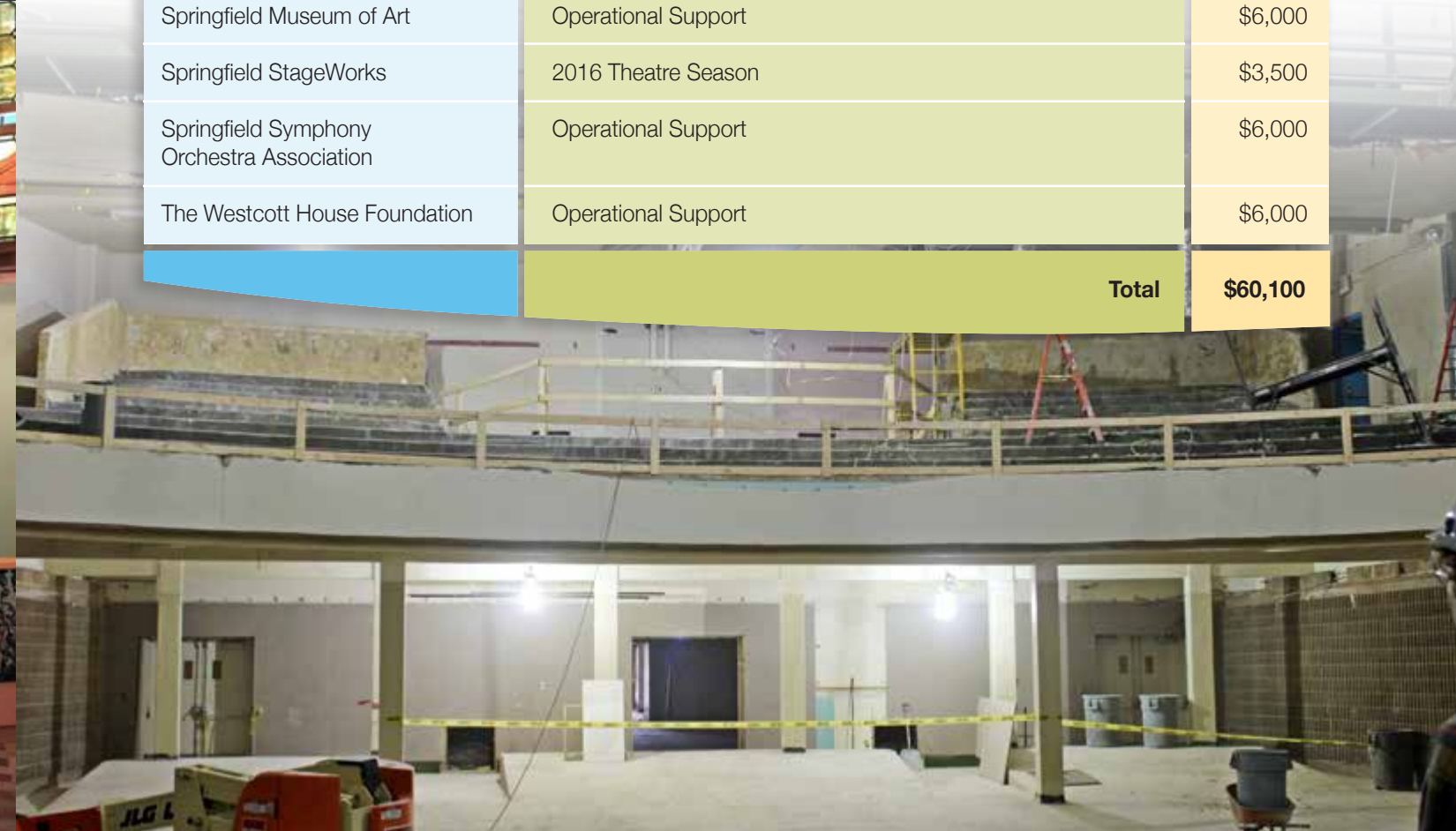


Arts & Culture

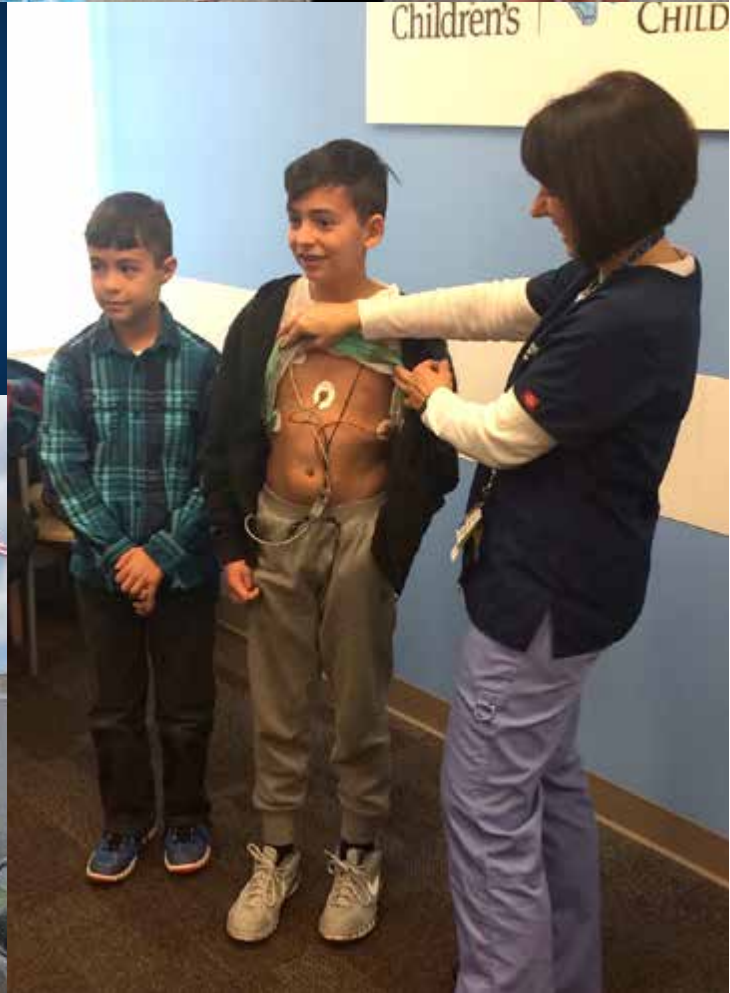

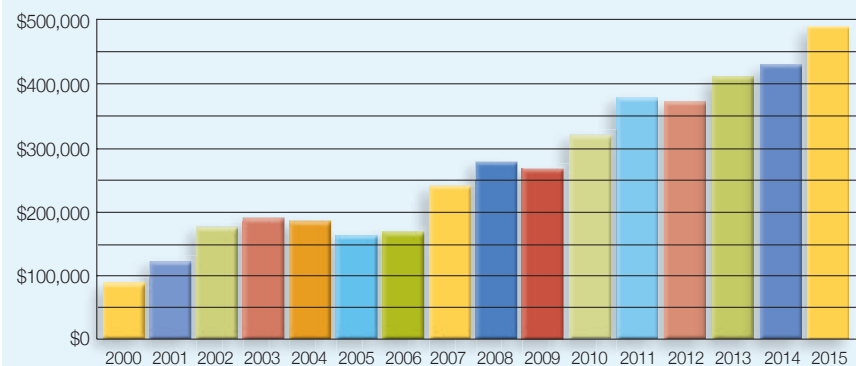

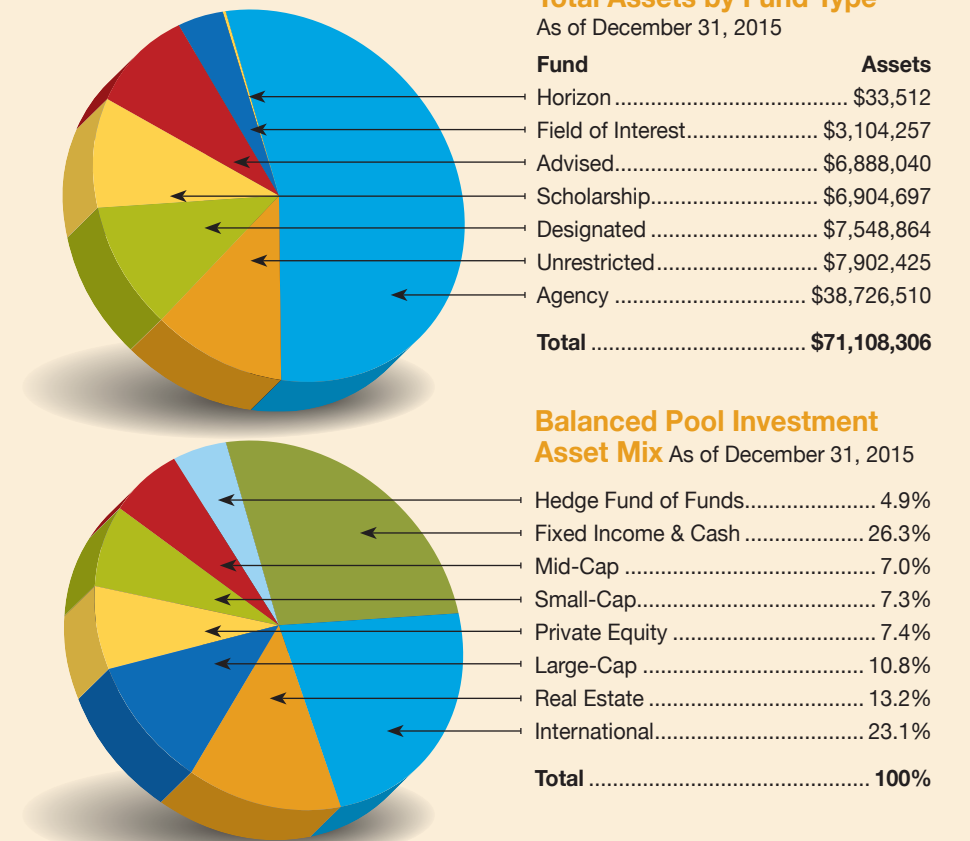

Investment Overview

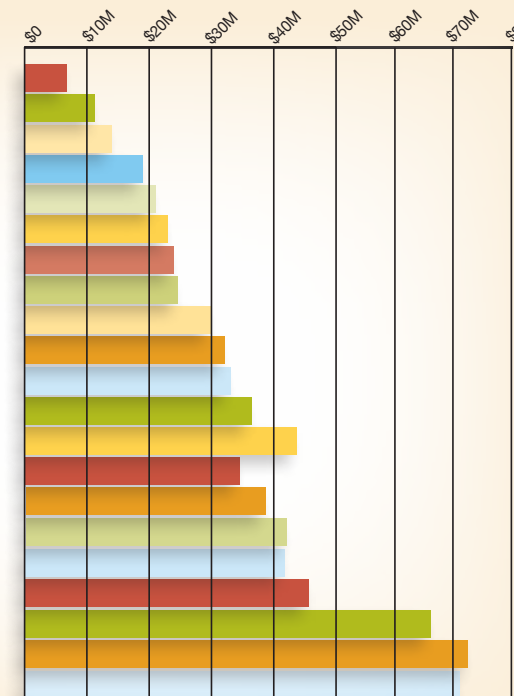
A majority of the Springfield Foundation's endowment funds is invested in a "Balanced Pool" portfolio, which is structured for long-term total return. To provide diversification and to reduce overall risk, the investments are divided into carefully defined asset classes. Assets are invested by professional money managers hired by the Foundation through a competitive process. The investment performance of each money manager is monitored by an independent investment consultant retained by the Foundation and overseen by the Foundation's Investment Committee. Growth in Total Assets

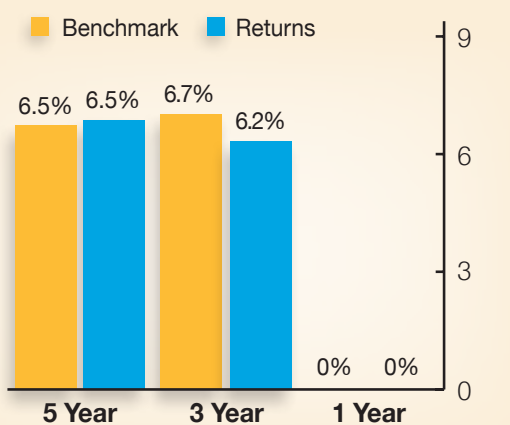
