Getting Started Is Easy

An Unrestricted fund is a personalized fund you create to impact our community for generations to come. A minimum of \$10,000 is needed to create your unrestricted fund. You can use cash, stock, or other assets gifted during your lifetime or at death to establish a named fund, qualify for an immediate income or estate tax deduction, and the Foundation will distribute grants that address our community's most pressing need.
